They also were the lead architect on the MGM National Harbor casino.

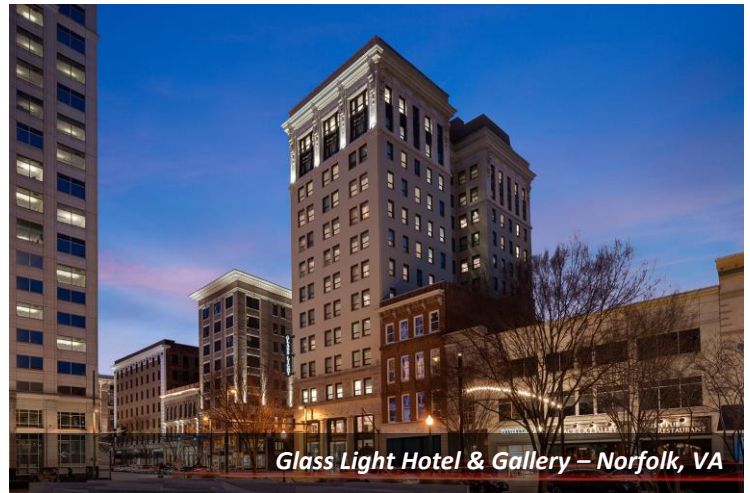


SoFi Stadium – Los Angeles, CA

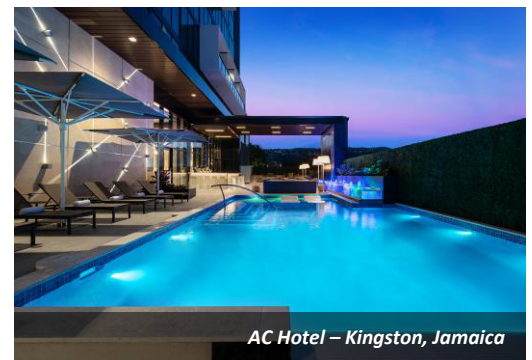
